Event of classification

- They will be able to participate all the countries members of CCS and of the areas PAQ II and Ill. They will also be able to participate the members associates recognized by Center Caribbean Sports (CCS), always and when have obtained his classification after have participated of the classification system established by PAQ.
- The classification for the Games HE you will get in a event qualifying in March of 2026 (by confirm). The squares HE will grant to the committees Olympics nationals (CONs) and No to the athletes.
- Each federation national will be able to be represented by a maximum of two athletes in each gender in the individual qualifying events.
- First priority of classification: HE will grant two (2) squares by gender for he host country, Republic Dominican.
- The vacancies that occurred, by disease, withdrawal, inability by proof of doping, sanctions either any other anomaly, will be replaced respecting he scale of the places obtained in the qualifying event.
- Of No be completed the squares assigned, PAQ HE booking he right of carry out the reassignment in common agreement with CCS.



Evidence individual

Each Committee Olympic National -WITH- will be able to participate with a maximum of two athletes classified in each individual event.

- a. For the maximum quota of competitors per individual test, the first positions will be taken into account. of agreement with he ranking Central American and of the Caribbean, the which they must of carry them out on the established dates until the maximum quota for each test is filled.
- b. HE there will be of use as a reference he ranking by evidence of World Athletics.

Evidence of Relays

For the men's and women's 4×100 m and 4×400 m relays, as well as the mixed 4×400 m relay, national teams will be qualified as follows:

- a. The 4 (four) members of each relay team with the maximum number of 6 (six) athletes (4x100m, 4x400m and 4x400m mixed), must be classified and registered in some individual event.
- b. Each NOC may register up to a maximum of 2 (two) competitors participating only in each relay race. For the mixed 4x400m relay, 1 woman and 1 man must register.

Squares of Universality

HE will observe the beginning of universality, parity and equity. All the WITH ' s have right to enroll to the less to a (1) man and a (1) women in any proof, taking in account the following aspects:

- a. The WITH 's they must of propose to the Committee Organizer, to the athlete man I women that occupies the better position in the classification world to the date of closing of the applications. The evidence superiors to 1,500 meters, So as the Evidence Combined No are eligible for universal places.
- b. The Technical Delegates will decide whether or not to accept such registration and will have the power to establish the proof I sportsman that will have right to participate in the games in base to the criterion of universality of classification.

Republic Dominican will classify automatically with a (1) athlete for all the evidence of Athletics where No have athletes classifieds, by be he country headquarters of the Games Central American Sports and of the Caribbean, Holy Sunday 2026. They must of to be observed the following aspects:

- a. In case of require 2 squares in a event, both athletes they must of be classifieds in it ranking
- b. Republic Dominican will determine he system of classification of their athletes for this competition.

Eligibility of the athletes

Only the WITH 's recognized by Center Caribbean Sport, whose Federations Nationals Athletics are affiliates to the WA / NACAC / Athletics South American they can register competitors in the Games Sports Central Americans and of the Caribbean, Holy Sunday 2026.

- a. The athletes they must have signed and delivered he form of conditions of eligibility of the athlete.
- b. The CON's they must of consider the following aspects of age of the participants:
 - Athletes aged 18 or 19 on 31 December 2026 (i.e. born in 2007 or 2008) may compete in any event except the Half Marathon and 42.195 km Marathon and Walking events.
 - Athletes aged 16 or 17 on 31 December 2026 (i.e. born in 2009 or 2010)
 may compete in any event except the Throwing, Combined, 10,000m, Half
 Marathon and the 21.098km and 42.195km Race Walking events .
 - None athlete minor of 16 years of age to the 31 of December of 2026 (is say, born in 2011 or later) can be registered.

Period for the classification

Athletics event ranking system will be used as a reference for the qualification system . The established dates are as follows:

a. For the Half Marathon, Race Walking, Combined Events, and 10,000 meters, they may be held between January 1, 2025, and June 6, 2026.

b. For the remaining tests, the established dates are from July 1, 2025, to June 6, 2026.

Validity of the results:

- a. The results must be achieved during competitions organized or sanctioned by World Athletics, its area associations (NACAC/Atletismo Sudamericano) or member federations and conducted in accordance with the rules of World Athletics and by which (commencing on January 1, 2025).
- b. Results obtained in school or university competitions must be certified by the member federation of the country in which the competition was held, and must comply with the authorizations of World Athletics and the respective Area Association.
- c. Results achieved in mixed-gender track events will not be accepted. Exceptionally, in accordance with Article 9 of the World Athletics Regulations , results achieved in the 5,000m and 10,000m events may be accepted in circumstances where there were not enough athletes of one or both genders competing to justify separate races and there was no passing or assistance by an athlete of one gender to an athlete of the other gender. Where appropriate, Member Federations must submit a specific request to their respective Area Association, providing the required documentation.
- d. Results obtained with a tailwind (greater than +2.0 m/s) will not be accepted.
- e. Manually timed results will not be accepted in the 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1,500m, 100m/110m hurdles, 400m hurdles, 4x100m, 4x400m relay, and 4x100m and 4x400m mixed relay events.
- f. The results of all field events held on indoor tracks, as well as races of 200m or more, will be accepted.
- g. Results for events of 200m or more obtained on oversized indoor tracks (more than 200m) will not be accepted.

From 1 January 2025, for Permitted National Competitions, in addition to compliance with the above, all results must be achieved in a competition for which an application has been submitted to World Athletics in advance. The list of such competitions will be published on the Global Calendar pages of the World Athletics website .

Race Walking

The results obtained in international race walking competitions as defined in Rule 1.1 (a), (b), (c), (d), I, (f), (g) or (j) of World Athletics will be valid for the ranking, provided that the following conditions are respected (where applicable):

- a. The course must contain a certificate from an international road race measurer of grade A or B approved by WA/AIMS.
- b. The measurement certificate must have been authorized no more than five years before the date of the competition.
- c. There will be a minimum of three international race walking judges.
- d. Results from track walking tests (20,000m and 35,000m) will be accepted.

Half Marathon

Only Half Marathon results that meet the following criteria will be considered valid for the minimum participation times:

Athlete Eligibility

To participate in the XXV Central American and Caribbean Games Santo Domingo 2026, athletes must comply with the provisions of the Games Regulations and the rules of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB). They must also be registered by their National Olympic Committee (NOC) in accordance with the Statutes of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

The minimum age allowed for participants is fourteen years of age at the start date of the event.

Minimum Participation.

For an event or test to be considered official, five (5) pairs and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate. In the event that one or more representations, after the Technical Meeting is held, are unable to participate due to force majeure, corroborated and verified by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), which is the only entity empowered to authorize the event. Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) will resolve the matter. The combination of athletes from different countries will not be permitted for the modalities and tests that are called for in the Central American and Caribbean Games Santo Domingo 2026.

NATIONALITY: Athletes participating in the XXV Central American and Caribbean Games Santo Domingo 2026 must have the nationality of the country they represent and of the National Olympic Committee (NOC) that registered them. Competitor nationality is determined in accordance with the (CCS) Regulations.

Confirmation of places

NORCECA will confirm to Centro Caribe Sport (CCS) and the NOCs that have qualified no later than January 15, 2026.

The NOCs will confirm the slots they will use to Centro Caribe Sport and NORCECA no later than January 25, 2026.

Reassignment of unused places

If necessary, NORCECA will confirm the reallocation of places no later than January 26, 2026. NOCs that have received reassigned places must confirm their participation before 31st January 2026.
